

Technical Visit Ringhals Nuclear Power Plant

Thursday August 27th, 2020. Departure with Bus from Göteborg 9 AM, return time 14 PM.

Ringhals is a nuclear power plant in Sweden. It is situated on the Värö Peninsula (Swedish: Väröhalvön) in Varberg Municipality approximately 65 km south of Gothenburg. With a total power rating of 3 GW, it is the largest power plant in Sweden and generates 23 TWh of electricity a year, the equivalent of 15% of the electrical power usage of Sweden.

The plant has 3 operating reactors: one boiling water reactor (R1) and two pressurized water reactors (R3 and R4). A third pressurized water reactor, R2, was permanently shut off in 2019.

After the bus tour, the visit starts with a presentation in the information centre, and then there will be a tour in the turbine hall, most likely it is unit Ringhals 3 that will be visited. The tour ends at the exhibition hall where there will be time for Q & A.
