



## Technical Visit Volvo Trucks

Thursday August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Departure with Bus from Göteborg 9.15 AM, return time noon.

Volvo Trucks (Swedish: Volvo Lastvagnar), stylized as VOLVO, is a global truck manufacturer based in Gothenburg, Sweden, owned by AB Volvo. The first Volvo truck rolled off the production lines in 1928, and in 2016 Volvo Trucks employed more than 52,000 people around the world. With global headquarters in Gothenburg, Sweden, Volvo manufactures and assembles its trucks in eight wholly owned assembly plants and nine factories owned by local interests.[3] Volvo Trucks produces and sells over 190,000 units annually.

A visit in the Tuve factory brings you into a modern truck factory. The tour will give you as visitor a good overview of how everything comes together from the driver hut to the engine mounting. You will hear about the work on the ergonomics in the factory, and details about how many cable ties that are consumed annually. After the tour there will be a possibility to ask the knowledgeable staff, if there is anything more you wish to know.
